

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-10-5

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS

WHEREAS, the posted maximum speed on a certain city street known as Galena Street, from Market Street to State Street, located within the City of Mt. Carroll, Illinois is 30 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the county engineer of Carroll County, Illinois has conducted a study of the aforescribed street to determine the volume of traffic and the speeds at which the traffic is moving, and has recommended that the posted speed limit be reduced from 30 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of public safety that the speed limit on the aforescribed street be reduced from 30 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour in the interests of public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. CARROLL, ILLINOIS that speed limit on Galena Street, from Market Street to State Street, be reduced from 30 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour. Further, that the appropriate traffic control devices and signs giving notice of maximum speed limits shall be erected upon the roadway, being affected by this change in the speed limit and that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the erection of said signs. Further, that said signs shall be erected in conformance with the standard specifications contained in the Illinois Manual for Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

Penalty: That the penalties for violating this ordinance shall be in conformance with the penalty provisions of the Mt. Carroll City Code.

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, and publication as required by law.


